# Mother's Day Celebration



Our learners of Grade V conducted a vibrant and informative assembly on the theme "Beat the Heat" to spread awareness about staying cool and safe during the scorching summer months.









An interactive , introductory robotics class for learners of Grade 8C thrilled the learners. Students look forward to many more fascinating sessions in the future.





# Assembly on 'The Unsung Heroes: A Tribute to labours

## Move & Groove


Zumba Time for Teachers!


