



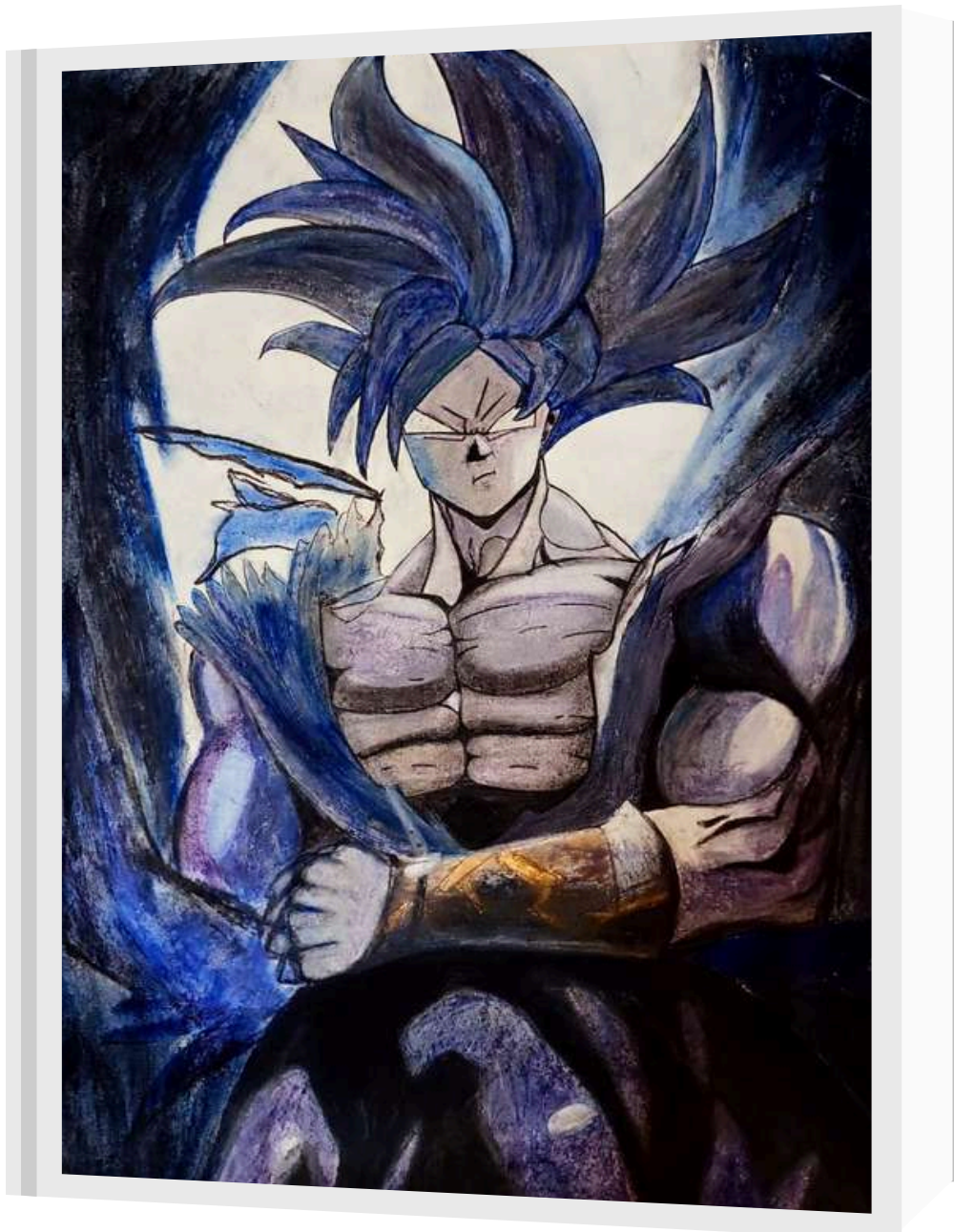

Learners also participated in Summer NaMa Experiential Theater Camp enhancing their communication, expression, teamwork, and performance skills through creative activities.



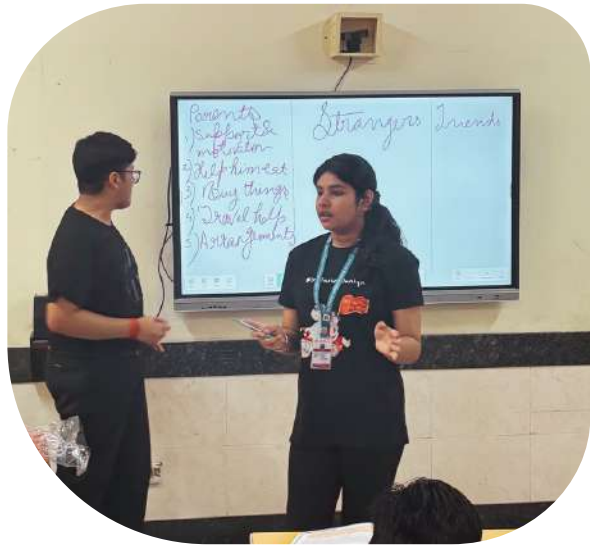
IDYC Boot Camp

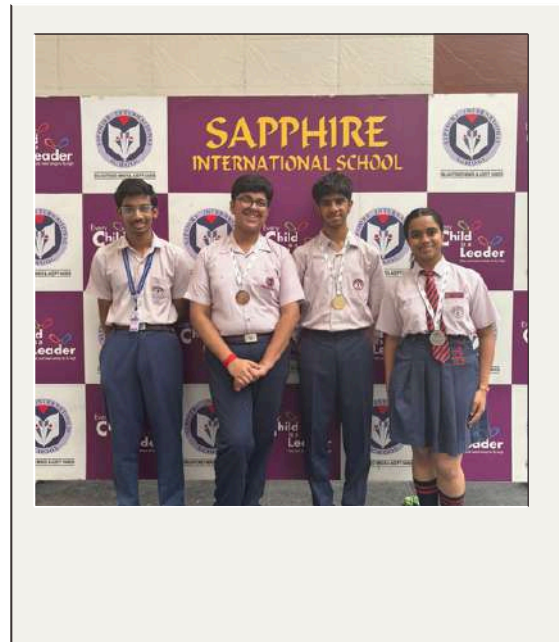

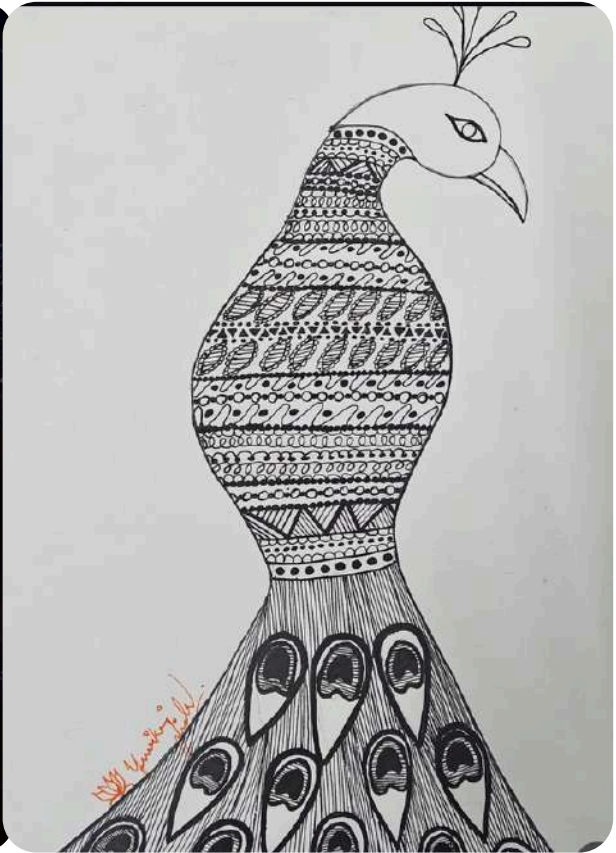

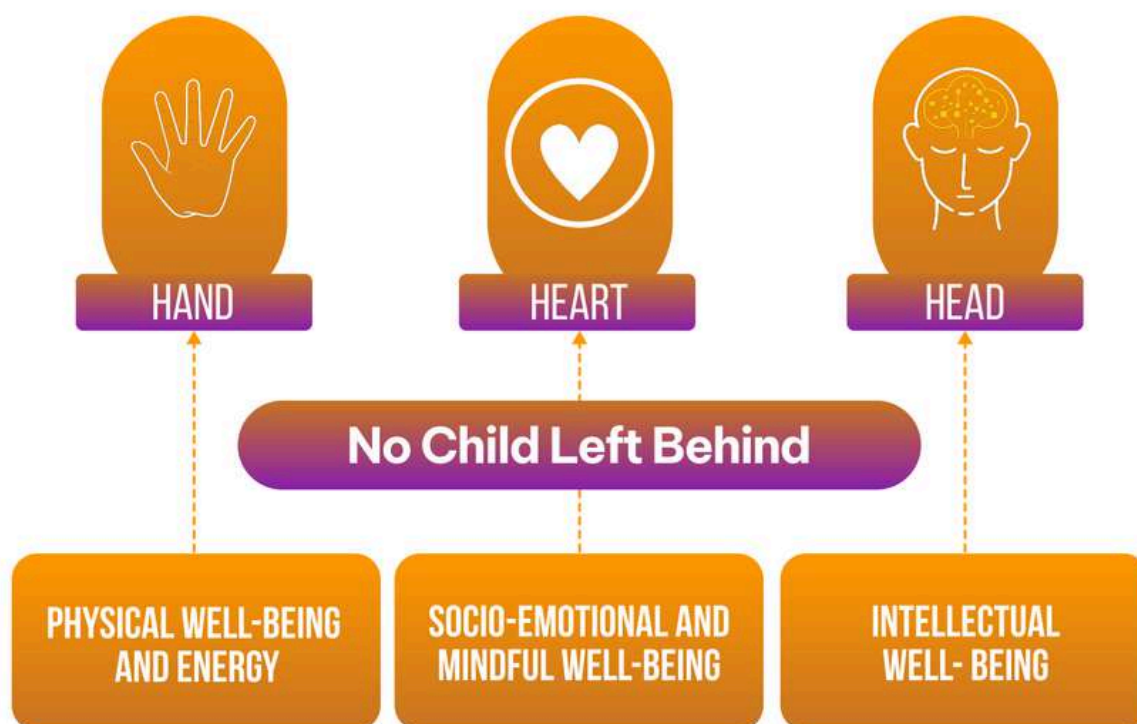
